

CONSERVATION PRACTICES AND PRACTICE PURPOSES

The Practice Codes and Names correlate directly to NRCS conservation practices that are found in the Field Office Technical Guide. Only conservation practices that are directly amenable to planning using the eVegGuide as the primary tool for species selection in revegetation are included in the eVegGuide.

Many conservation practices have descriptive divisions corresponding to practice purposes that summarize, synthesize (and for some practices condense) purposes noted for a conservation practice in that practice's National Standard. When working within the eVegGuide, if you have a choice of practice purpose for a given conservation practice, a drop-down list provides the available choices from which a primary purpose for the practice must be selected.
